Key Responsibilities

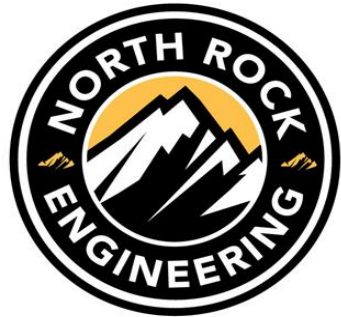
A summary of the key responsibilities associated with this position will include the following:
